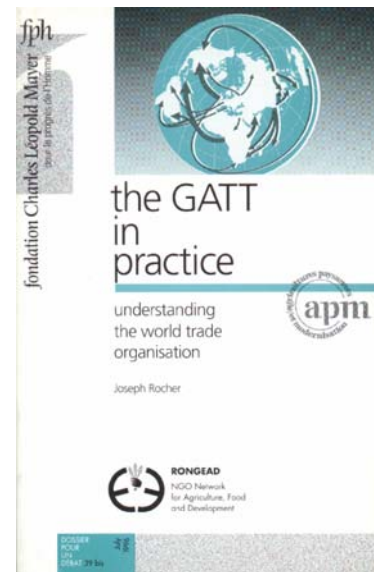

The aim of this publication is to introduce the beginnings and past of this institution, formally called GATT and, especially, to offer a better understanding of the way it works. It is directed at all those who have experienced certain difficulties following the negotiations of the Uruguay Round.

It focuses on GATT as an organisation. The first part consists of a study of GATT's documents, which deals with the definition of dumping and the consequences that this can have on the development of European agricultural policies, on the economy of agricultural produce in developing countries and those of central and eastern Europe.

The last part of the document lays out proposals and a list of recommendation for further thought, although this was not main objective of the work.

We would like to add that this document is a contribution to the APM network which is part of the Foundation for Human Progress (FPH), who financed this project.
